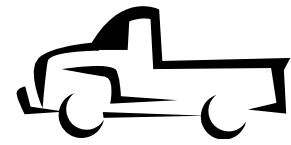


Mulch & Stone Pick Ups



Small Pickups (6' bed or less)

Jeep Comanche
 Ford Ranger
 Chevy S-10
 Dodge Dakota
 Toyota
 Nissan
 Isuzu
 Sonoma

Will hold approximately:
 1 yard of mulch or
 1/2 yard of topsoil or stone

****1 yard of topsoil or stone can weigh 1.6 tons (3200 lbs.)**

Full Size Pickups (7' beds)

GMC $\frac{3}{4}$ ton
 Ford F150
 Chevy 1500
 Dodge Ram

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of mulch level or 2 yards heaped
 1 yard of topsoil or stone

F250 Super Duty

2-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards of mulch
 2 yards of topsoil

Oversized Pickups

3 yards of mulch
 1 yard of topsoil or stone

1 Yard is equal to 27 cu. ft.

1 yard of Mulch/Stone/Topsoil covers 100 sq.ft. 3" deep (10'x10'x3")

1 yard Mulch equals 9 bags (3 cu.ft.) or 14 bags (2 cu.ft.)

1 yard of Topsoil equals 40 bags / Stone equals 54 bags

1yard mulch is approximately 5-7 wheelbarrow loads (depending on size & volume)

1yard mulch is approximately 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ 32 gallon garbage cans

One 2-cubic foot bag of mulch covers: 8 square feet (3"deep) or 12 square feet (2"deep)

One 3-cubic foot bag of mulch covers: 12 square feet (3"deep) or 18 square feet (2"deep)

Our trucks hold:

Mulch: Large Truck = 18-20 yards, Small Truck = 4 yards

Topsoil/Stones: Large Truck = 6 yards, Small Truck = 2 yards
